“Lighter ruby-colored, the 2016 Pinot Noir Toulouse Vineyard boasts a knockout nose of sweet red and black fruits intermixed with loads of spice and incense notes. It’s medium to full-bodied, has loads of texture, yet stays fresh and elegant, with a light, graceful texture. Aged 11 months in one-third new French oak, bottled unfined and unfiltered, drink it over the coming 6-7 years.”
